



## Safety is “Behavior for Life” – A Company-Wide Safety Ethic

The KASE/Warbonnet safety program is based upon the principle that all accidents and health-risk exposures can be prevented. Every employee believes they are responsible for their own safety and that of their fellow employees. KASE/Warbonnet’s management embraces the idea that they are responsible for enforcing safety rules, and should be held accountable for ensuring the safest possible work environment.

As a result of this company-wide safety ethic, KASE/Warbonnet completed over 300,000 work-hours without a lost-time or recordable accident.

### We Plan for Safety

Before any job starts, all potential hazards are identified in a formal, written Job Planning Safety Analysis (JPSA). All potential hazards are identified, with employees briefed on the proper Personal Protective Equipment required for specific tasks and the hazards associated with any chemicals they may be handling.



An updated JPSA is completed each day, on every job being performed. This ongoing, formalized safety awareness program has been a key ingredient in the company's sterling safety record.

In addition to the JPSA program, KASE/Warbonnet conducts project-specific safety reviews as appropriate to each project.

## Ongoing Safety Training

All KASE/Warbonnet employees have completed 40-hour Hazardous Waste Operator training and are certified to handle RCRA wastes.

Employees also have training in DOT, confined space, phosphorous safety standards, Personal Protective Equipment, use of fire extinguishers, electrical safety, and hazardous work permits.

Most KASE/Warbonnet employees are also cross-trained in rigging, cutting/welding, plasma cutters, band saws/grinders, forklifts, and man-lifts, and receive specialty safety training in heavy equipment operation and decontamination safety.

In addition, KASE/Warbonnet employees are trained in hazard communication, ergonomics, Lock-out/Tag-out, excavation safety, scaffold use, fall protection and ladder safety.

Kase/Warbonnet has a certified ROCO rescue team and has several employees trained in first aid and CPR.

The company has a full respiratory hazard safety program, including medical evaluations, respirator fit tests for both half-mask air purifying respirators and full face supplied air and self-contained breathing apparatuses.
